Description/qualifications of eligible participants	Applicants from São Paulo must adhere to the overall rules and conditions of a Regular Research Grant ("APR"), as outlined by FAPESP, superseded by the specific guidelines for this Call available at www.fapesp.br/belmontforum . Eligibility conditions and restrictions follow those of the APR modality, with an additional requirement for well-established researchers with a proven track record of interdisciplinary international projects in the themes of the Call. A specific eligibility check procedure is mandatory and must be requested by 31 December 2024. Details are available at www.fapesp.br/belmontforum
Stipulations for the maximum number of researchers in the consortium	Only one applicant researcher per proposal (consortium) can receive direct funds from FAPESP; other local researchers are welcomed as "associates"
Type of contribution + amount of contribution (R\$)	Monetary Total amount contribution of R\$7 million (aprox EUR1.27 million)
Maximum amount that can be requested per project or by researcher (R\$)	R\$600K Details for budget conditions and limitations are available at the specific FAPESP guidelines at www.fapesp.br/belmontforum
Restrictions for use of funds	Usual conditions of FAPESP's research Grants apply, plus the limitations specific for this Call, i.e., equipment, and software licenses
Specific themes within the Call	All themes are eligible for FAPESP funding. FAPESP is also participating in the Belmont Forum Africa Regional CRA. Since the list of funders, and hence, of research partners is different in each CRA, São
